



Dear Year 6,

Over the summer, I would like you to complete a project called Fantasy Island. This involves you designing your own imaginary island. You can make up all the facts about your island. Think about where it will be located in the world, the climate, what special attractions it has that make people want to visit it etc.

There are 4 tasks you must complete and then several other suggested tasks which are optional, or you can include other ideas of your own.

START: Design a front cover with the name of your island.

Task 1: (sheet in folder)

Complete the fact sheet about your island, showing the name, monthly temperatures, the size, the language, the currency (what money does it have e.g. Euros, dollars or your own invented currency?), population (how many people live there).

Task 2: (sheet in folder)

- A) Complete the location sheet- draw your island on the grid and explain where it is located in the world.
- B) Design a flag for your island. Think about the colours and shapes you will use on your flag.

Task 3:

Art: Design an exotic bird to live on your island and make a collage picture of it. You can use cut out paper, fabric, feathers etc. Give it a name.

Task 4: (sheet in folder)

Make a mini holiday brochure about your island to persuade people to visit. Sub-headings should include

- a description of your island
- the climate
- a bit about the history
- information about places for tourists to visit - write about at least two special places or landmarks eg. is there an ancient monument, an amazing theme park or a magnificent art gallery etc?

Once you have completed the 4 tasks, you may like to do more. You can choose other tasks to complete from the ideas list in the folder, or you may have other ideas of your own. You can do as many as you wish. I would like you to bring your project back to school in September please.

You can be as creative as you like. For example, you may feel inspired to make a model of your island or make a holiday advert for your island using video. It is really up to you.
