



### Other Ideas

You can select any of the ideas below. Do as many as you like, or use any of your own ideas.

- Make up 5 laws/rules for your island
- Make a model of your island
- Design a banknote for your currency.
- Create a line graph of monthly temperatures
- Write the grid coordinates for your island
- Draw a treasure-style map and write grid references for famous landmarks on the island.
- Make a phrase book for tourists to translate language phrases  
Eg. How to say: "Hello", "Please", "Thank-you" in your island's language
- Message in a bottle: imagine someone has been shipwrecked on your island in the past, perhaps before it was inhabited. Maybe they even discovered the island. Write the message they might put in the bottle. Include details of their shipwreck, their thoughts and feelings on arriving on the island and their plea to be rescued.
- How to... instructions for survival on the island. If you had been shipwrecked on the island, you could write a survival guide to help others e.g. how to build a shelter; how to avoid being eaten by wild animals; what to eat etc. (Think Bear Grylls).
- Write a story about your island- often places have mythical tales passed down through the centuries, sometimes they include magic. You could make up an adventure story or a magical or ghostly tale about your island.
- National dress- draw a national costume for your island.
- Create a food dish that your island is well-known for. You can write the recipe and you may even like to cook it.

- New species fact file- features, adaptations, habitat, diet, predators etc.
- Create a national identity- make up a national anthem; you can write the lyrics and music. You might even record yourself singing it!
- Famous residents - you can make up some characters to live on your island
- Does your island have a Royal family? Prime Minister or president? Write about them and/or draw them.
