Joshua is a highly acclaimed, award-winning professional poet, performer and educator who uses poetry to develop literacy skills and inspire confidence and creativity in communication. He has had several books published and has performed for BBC television. As part of our reading comprehension lessons in school, the children have studied some of his work and during library sessions this half term the children will have the opportunity to explore more of his writing. During his visit, Joshua will deliver assemblies to EYFS/KS1 and separately to KS2 (cost on School Money). He will also be running workshops for KS2. After school on the day, Joshua will be selling copies of his books. The books will be priced at £7 a copy if you wish to purchase these.
