

Key Stage 2 School and National Comparative Data 2025

The chart below compares our own school data for Year 6 against the national data for Key Stage 2 in 2025.

For reading, spelling, grammar and punctuation, and mathematics, the data is based on the outcomes of the national tests. For writing and science, the data is based on teacher assessment.

The data shows the percentage of children either working towards the expected standard, achieving the expected standard, or achieving above the expected standard in each of the core subjects.

There is currently no data available to show the national percentage of children achieving **above the expected standard**, but we have included that data for our school.
